Defeating Discouragement

When David was a young boy his tools to defeat the enemy, Goliath, were a slingshot and one smooth stone. However, that stone, and David's strength, were not the reason for David's victory; it was the power of God! We read in Ephesians 6 that, to have victory over our enemy the devil, God has given us tools, as well—our Bibles, prayer and His power.

An often-used and effective tool of the devil is discouragement. Down-spiraling discouragement leads to depression and worse. "A prudent man foreseeth the evil . . ." (Proverbs 22:3).


God wants us to be prepared and to "be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might" (Ephesians 6:10), and when discouragement strikes, or any other tool in Satan's tool belt, "take . . . the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God" (Ephesians 6:17).

- Ponder God's Promises. He loves you, is always with you and holds your hand (Romans 8:35–37; Hebrews 13:5; Isaiah 41:13).
- Place your Trust in God's power. He is in control. He works all things for good (Proverbs 19:21; Romans 8:28).
- Proclaim His Praise. Praise defeats the enemy (2 Chronicles 20:1-22).

"Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him" (Psalm 42:11). These words from David in the Bible should inspire us to grab hold of God's power and defeat discouragement.

"Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory . . . Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name" (1 Chronicles 29:11, 13).
