Be Ready!

“The British are coming! The British are coming!” Actually, according to biographical accounts, Paul Revere never uttered those exact words. The important thing is that Mr. Revere spread the warning. His speedy ride to Lexington on April 18, 1775, that carved his name into history, was made to warn John Hancock and Samuel Adams of the approaching British who wanted to arrest them.

Paul Revere and two other men were also messengers appointed to rouse the Minutemen to battle. Minutemen were elite, hand-picked, highly trained and ready to assemble within a half-hour’s time to protect their towns.

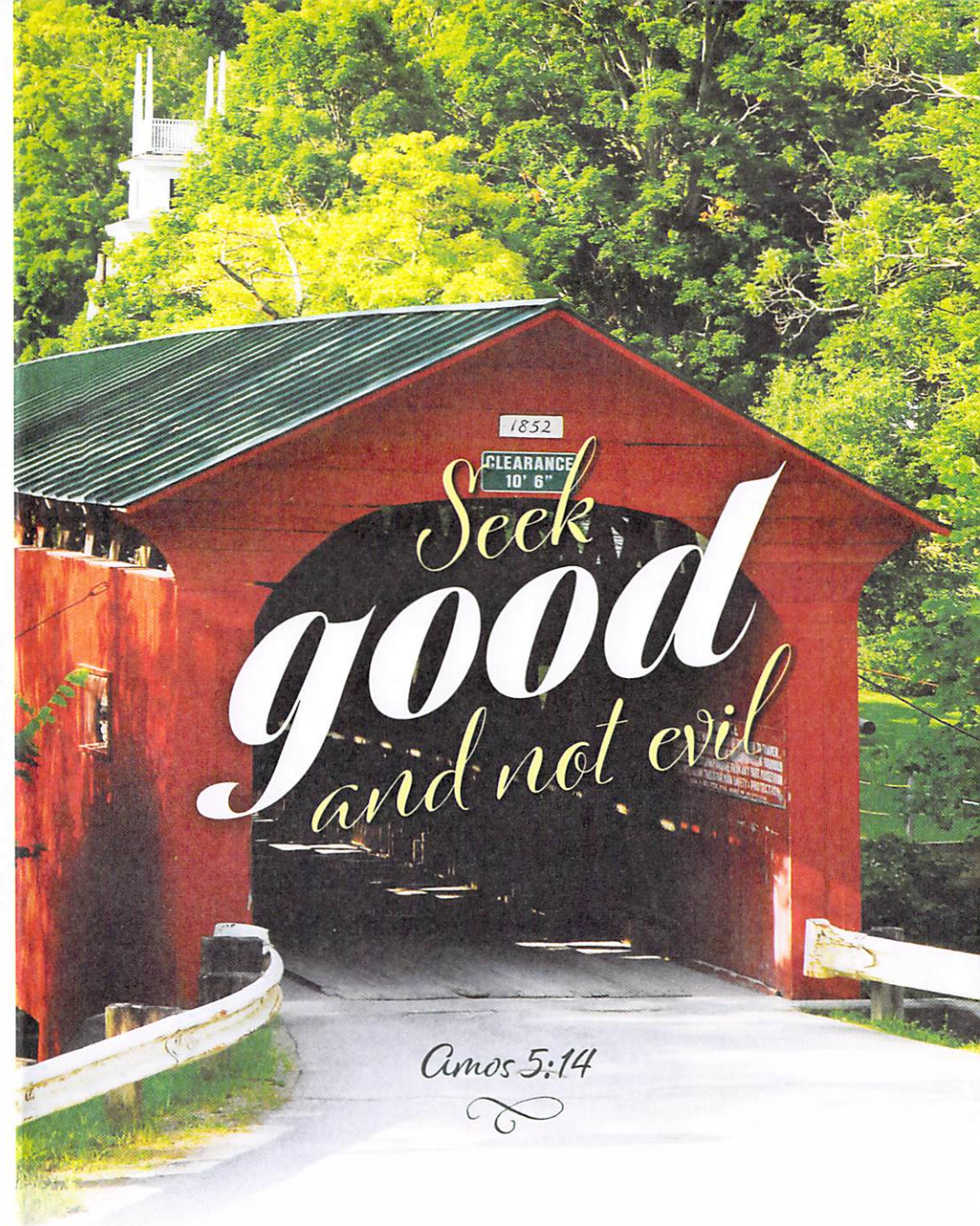
God has chosen us to be His messengers, as well. “Jesus is coming! Jesus is coming!” is to be our cry. Like the Israelites who, with traveling clothes on, sandals on their feet and their staff in hand, ate the Passover dinner before leaving Egypt, so are we to be Minutemen and women, ready to go for Jesus—wherever He leads (Exodus 12:11).

- We are to be always ready to tell others the good news of the gospel (1 Peter 3:15).
- We are to be ready to forgive (Colossians 3:12-13).
- We are to be ready to do good works and help others (Titus 3:1).
- We are to be ready to listen and learn when we go to God’s house (Ecclesiastes 5:1).
- And most importantly, we are to be ready when Jesus returns. “For in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh” (Matthew 24:44).
